

Overnight showers help Delhi bridge Jan deficit

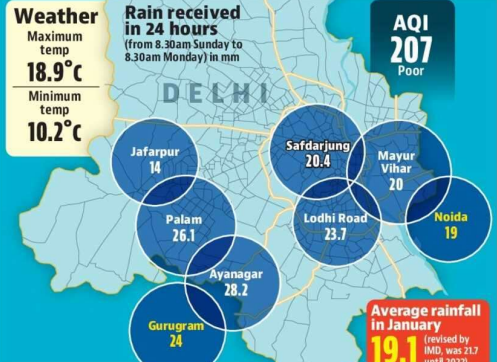

NEW DELHI: A western disturbance influencing north-west India led to Delhi recording 20-mm of rain between Sunday and Monday, data from the India Meteorological Department (IMD) showed. Before the rain on Sunday and Monday, Delhi had received only trace rainfall on January 12, and the showers that continued overnight allowed Delhi to comfortably cross the normal average of 19.1mm for the entire month in just a 24-hour period. IMD defines a western disturbance as an area of "disturbed" or reduced air pressure, moving from the west to the east, carrying with it moisture associated with rainfall, snowfall and fog in northern India. According to IMD data, Safdarjung, which is considered representative of the Capital's weather, recorded 20.4mm of rain between 8.30am on Sunday and 8.30am on Monday. Meanwhile, the station at Palam recorded 26.1mm of rain, while it was 23.7mm at Lodhi Road, 21.5mm at the Ridge and 28.2mm at Ayanagar.

Met officials said the disturbance is in the process of withdrawing, and forecast mainly clear skies with strong winds for the next three days. "Now that the western disturbance is beginning to withdraw, wind speed will pick up in the region and cold north-westerly winds will return, leading to a drop in the minimum temperature by 1-2 degrees over the next two days," said Kulddeep Srivastava, scientist at IMD. Srivastava said Delhi will see clear skies during the day, while wind speed could be between 25-35 kmph over the next three days.

According to Met data, Delhi has recorded surplus rainfall every January for the last four years. Last year, Delhi received 58.2mm of rain in January - an all-time record for the month for the 122 years that IMD records exist. In 2021, Delhi recorded 56.6mm of rain in January, while the figures for 2020

and 2019 were 48.1mm and 54.1mm respectively. The last time Delhi had a rain deficit in January was in 2018, when the city only logged 4.4mm. The rain also led to an improvement in Delhi's pollution levels, which dipped back to the "poor" zone with an Air Quality Index (AQI) reading of 207, according to the Central Pollution Control Board's daily national bulletin. In comparison, Delhi's AQI reading was 331 (very poor) on Sunday. Forecasts show Delhi's AQI is likely to remain in the "poor" category on Tuesday. An AQI reading between zero and 50 is considered "good", 51 and 100 "satisfactory", 101 and 200 "moderate", 201 and 300

"poor", 301 and 400 "very poor", and 401 and 500 "severe". "Delhi's AQI will be in the 'poor' category on January 31 and while it will improve on February 1 and 2, it will still be in the 'poor' category," said the Early Warning System for Delhi, a forecasting model under the ministry of earth sciences. Prior to this, Delhi last recorded trace rainfall on January 12 - a day when the city broke a 91-day streak of no rain. Delhi had not received rain since October 12, 2022, when it got 0.4mm of rain.

TWO STUDENT GROUPS CLASH IN SOUTH DELHI, TEEN STABBED TO DEATH

NEW DELHI: A violent clash between two groups of students near Hansraj Sathi Park near Kalkaji in south Delhi led to the murder of a Class 12 student of Kalkaji School Number-2 on Monday afternoon, police said. The student had suffered stab wounds and was admitted to a local hospital, where he succumbed to his injuries in the evening. A case of murder was registered at the Kalkaji police station and investigation started, police said.

DCP (southeast) Esha Pandey said that at around 2.30pm, they received information that Mohan alias Mania, an 18-year-old student from Okhla Phase-2 was admitted to Purnima Hospital with a stab injury to the chest. A police team reached the hospital and found the student's injury was serious. Accordingly, a case of attempt to murder was registered. "The victim later died during treatment and the case was converted into Section 302 (murder) of IPC. There was a quarrel between two groups of students in which he sustained injuries. Our team is checking CCTV footage to identify and nab the suspects," said DCP Pandey.

Mughal Garden, in DU, renamed after Buddha

NEW DELHI: The Mughal Garden at the Delhi University has been renamed the Gautam Buddha Centenary Garden, according to a notification issued by the varsity last week. "The competent authority of university of Delhi has approved the name of the Garden (opposite the Viceroyal lodge) with the statue of Gautam Buddha in its centre as 'Gautam Buddha Centenary Garden'," the January 27 notification, issued by registrar Vikas Gupta, said.

The university's move came a day before the iconic Mughal Gardens at the Rashtrapati Bhavan were rechristened Amrit Udayan. According to Gupta, the garden at DU was never formally given the name Mughal Garden. "The notification was issued as part of the centenary celebrations of the university. In none of our records is the garden identified as Mughal Garden. We have named the garden since it has a statue of Lord Buddha," he said. However, there are several examples of the garden being called "Mughal Garden" in official university documents, and in

even on its website. A letter dated February 10, 2022, issued by the secretary of the DU garden committee to college principals, for example, identified the garden in front of the vice-chancellor's office as the Mughal Garden. The university's annual flower show took place in the same garden last year. "This is to inform you that the 64th Annual Flower Show of the University of Delhi is scheduled to be held on 4th March 2022 at the Mughal Garden (in front of V-C's office) University of Delhi," the February 10 letter stated. The garden also found a mention on the university website, where it is identified as a popular destination. "The university gardens have several landscape elements. A popular destination for students, teachers, and the public is the famous Mughal Garden," the website says. Abha Dev Habib, who teaches physics at Miranda House, said that the exercise was an attempt to rewrite history. "The name Mughal comes from a certain architectural style. Even the gardens at the Rashtrapati Bhavan were renamed recently. This move is another attempt to rewrite history," said Habib.

Delhi HC tells medical board to examine teen who wants to abort 25-week foetus

NEW DELHI: The Delhi high court on Monday asked a medical board at the Safdarjung Hospital to examine a 13-year-old rape victim, who has moved court seeking permission to terminate her 25-week pregnancy. The minor moved court after the medical board at Safdarjung had opined that the abortion could not be allowed as the gestation period was more than 24 weeks. On Monday, justice Prathiba M Singh asked the medical board to examine the minor afresh while detailing the risk to her or the foetus, in case medical

termination of the pregnancy is carried out. The court noted that even though the medical board has opined that the pregnancy cannot be terminated due to the gestational period of 24 weeks, there is no clarity in the opinion as to whether there is any risk

taken for an ultrasound on January 18, when she was found to be 23 weeks and six days pregnant. It said that the family then approached Safdarjung, following which a first information report (FIR) was registered under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 on January 21.

The petition further said that a case was also registered under the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015, with the Child Welfare Committee (district south), following which the letter on January 23 directed that the CMO, Safdarjung hospital take the necessary decision under the Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1971.
